While there are currently no COVID-19 restrictions in Scotland, we will follow the official guidance in place at the time of the conference.

If things stay as they are, we ask that you don't attend if you have any COVID-19 symptoms and that all delegates take a lateral flow test before travelling to the conference.

Should you be unable to attend due to a positive test or someone in your household testing positive, we regret that we won't be able to offer any refunds after the cancellation cut-off date (21 July). You will, however, be able to access the virtual conference – allowing you to take part at a distance – and the recordings.

The venue also has COVID-19 measures in place to keep delegates safe, which you can access here.

During the conference we will support those who choose to wear a mask and/or practise social distancing and will expect other delegates to respect that decision too.

Should COVID-19 restrictions make it impossible for the in-person conference to go ahead, in-person delegates will receive a refund of the difference between the fee they've paid and the online fee, and the conference will be held exclusively online.
